NARRATIVE  
ON 3/28/2011, I OFFICER HARRINGTON , TOOK A WALK IN REPORT AT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT. I SPOKE WITH MS. SUSAN WHITE, WHO STATED THAT ON FRIDAY NIGHT SHE WAS SEXUALLY ASSAULTED.

MS. WHITE STATED THAT MS. JOYCE FREELAND SENT MS. WHITE A TEXT MESSAGE AT APROX 550 ASKING IF SHE WANTED TO JOIN HER AND MR. TOM FREELAND FOR DINNER AT CITY GROCERY.

MS. WHITE STATED THAT SHE ARRIVED AT CITY GROCERY AT APPROX 1815 AND MET THE COUPLE FOR DINNER AND SOME DRINKS. AT ONE POINT IN THE NIGHT, MS. WHITE STATED MR. FREELAND AND MS. FREELAND GOT INTO AN ARGUMENT AND SHE GOT UP AND LEFT. MS. WHITE STATED AT THAT POINT, WHEN MS. FREELAND LEFT, MR. FREELAND PICKED UP HER HAND AND HELD IT. MS. WHITE THEN STATED SHE GOT UP AND LEFT AFTER THAT AS WELL.

MS. WHITE STATED ON HER WAY HOME, SHE STOPPED BY THE ALUMNI HOUSE ON CAMPUS TO TRY AND FIND HER HUSBAND. MS. WHITE STATED THAT MR. FREELAND FOLLOWED HER TO THE ALUMNI HOUSE AND YELLED TO HER, ASKING IF SHE WAS OK. WHEN SHE LEFT THE ALUMNI HOUSE, SHE WENT HOME TO 105 GLEN EAGLE ROAD, WHERE SHE PARKED HER CAR IN THE CARPORT THEN WALKED UP TO THE BACK DOOR. MS. WHITE STATED THAT SHE STOPPED IN FRONT OF THE DOOR AND PUT HER CAR KEYS IN HER PURSE THEN GOT HER HOUSE KEYS OUT. MS. WHITE STATED WHEN SHE UNLOCKED THE LOCK AND BEGAN TURNING THE DOOR KNOB, MR. FREELAND CAME UP FROM BEHIND HER AND SLAMMED THE DOOR OPEN AND PUSHED HER INSIDE.

MS. WHITE RECEIVED NUMEROUS TEXT MESSAGES FROM MR. FREELAND THE NEXT DAY, REFERENCING THE INCIDENT THAT OCCURED.

MS. WHITE DID NOT WANT TO SIGN CHARGES ON MR. FREELAND AT THE TIME AND I ADVISED HER THAT SINCE SHE WAS UNCERTAIN ON WHAT TO DO, TO SIT DOWN WITH HER HUSBAND AND DECIDE ON HOW THEY WANT TO HANDLE THE SITUATION. MS. WHITE ALSO STATED THE MAIN REASON SHE WAS HESITANT TO SIGN CHARGES IS BECAUSE THE FREELANDS ARE ALL LAWYERS.

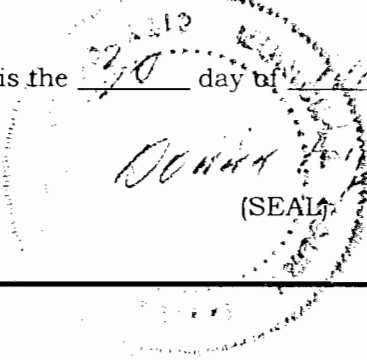
